Also in this volume are six stories of Aesop s that teach Christian values, including The Shepherd Boy Who Cried Wolf, The Mouse and the Lion, and The Wind and the Sun. Rev. Springer uses Bible verses as guides to the lessons imparted by the classic fables and provides simple questions after each to stimulate thinking about the moral message contained in the simple tales.
